

Things you should know about the program	
Program Title	Multi-Cultural Management
Duration (years)	3 (maximum duration under Erasmus) which can be renewed with a slightly different title e.g. Advanced Multicultural Management etc
Coordinating Institution	TEI of Crete . May be changed subsequent years
Venue	Aghios Nikolaos , Crete, Greece for first year. Leon Spain for year two. Proposals for year three are invited.
Time	Year one – Either 8 to 23 of May 2010 or 15 to 30 of May 2010
Participant Students	Up to 60 undergraduate or postgraduate students from partner institutions (not including student of coordinating institution) irrespective of their nationality.
Participant Academics	Up to 20 staff members from participating institutions
Eligible Partner Institutions	Higher Institutions of the 27 EU member states, Turkey and the three European Economic Area countries. All institutions must be Erasmus University Charter holders
Funding	The following expenses for students and staff members are covered: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accommodation (maximum 14 days), food (three meals per day) and cultural activities 100% • Tickets (air) 75% <p><u>Notes:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student accommodation in twin bed rooms of 3* hotels. Staff accommodation in single rooms of 4 or 5* hotels. 2. Lunch for students will be provided at the Students Restaurant. No restriction for staff members. 3. All efforts will be made for tickets to be compensated 100% but for now we keep the 75%.
Motivation	Students and staff members will have the opportunity to combine training/teaching with spending two weeks in Aghios Nikolaos in late spring (the best time of the year in Crete) and getting acquainted with (perhaps) the oldest civilization in European soil.
